Moore's Law:

Computers Going Faster All the Time

In 1965 Gordon Moore, one of the founders of Intel, predicted that the number of transistors per square inch of integrated circuit would double every 1-2 years. To you this means that the speed of a computer will double about every 18 months.

The good news is speed. The bad news is that you will never see an end to upgrades.

Once machines go faster, software is written to take advantage of the speed. New machines go faster than old machines.

If you don't replace computers every three years, you have a dramatic decrease in productivity. So you replace machines. And then it hits you: The oldest, slowest, least powerful machine in the office is **the server**.

More Than Speed

But servers require more than speed. There are many benefits to a new server. There's **what you get** and what you **get rid of**.

With a new server you get a machine that's more stable, more secure, and probably has a lot more storage space. If you take all the news reports about hackers and viruses and spyware from the last three years, you'll see that there's a lot of scary stuff out there. New servers are designed to address all those issues. So your company's more secure.

You get rid of old equipment. The single greatest cause of computer down-time is old hardware. A three year old server has three year old hard drives that have been spinning 24 hours a day, seven days a week, for three years. That's more than 26,000 hours of non-stop usage.

It's not a question of **whether** it will fail, but **when** it will fail.
